- Help and assistance of the local community in organization of different developmental programs.

Benefits of local community:-

KLE Society's College of Education is affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad. Our institution inculcates social value and responsibilities to the faculty members and students by imparting extension activities in the neighborhood for holistic development of the society. Through extension and outreach programmes, we sensitize the students to develop social values, widespread their responsibilities and knowledge in societal issues and problems by making them to involve with the community people. Our outreach activities are controlled by the IQAC coordinator of the institution. In this college we have one unit of Cultural committee headed by IQAC Co-ordinator to execute various outreach activities throughout the year. They are instrumental in converting students in to the responsible citizens of the country by developing discipline, values and ethics of social life. Every year, KLE College celebrates ENVIRONMENT DAY. A campaign for Tree plantation is carried out nearby area and awareness for care of the new planted trees is generated among community people. The Blood bank has been enriched through the BLOOD DONATION CAMP that led to donating of blood Through various outreach activities & other awareness creating programmes which are organized in our college helped to spread awareness about health care, cleanliness, environment protection, social equality etc.

2. Practice teaching /internship in schools

The institution in collaboration with the school, in its locality, institution conducts the community outreach activities for partial fulfillment of the requirements of the B. Ed. Program in particular and community based awareness programmes as extension activities beyond the B. Ed. Curriculum. The institution collaborates with the schools for internship programme conducted by the students in the schools by keeping and maintaining healthy rapport with the school authorities.

Information obtained from the school heads where the student teachers are engaged for their internship work. While preparing the academic plan, top most priority is given on the suitable period for the school and of the institution during which the school internship

will be conducted.

Conducting the school internship programme in different schools with proper stress and intention to fulfill its purposes.

Practice Teaching: As the newly developed curriculum has focused on school internship where practice teaching plays a vital role in making them effective teachers along with providing scope to be a good sociable human beings by accepting them as regular teachers during their stay in the schools for delivering 8 practice teaching lessons as per the NCTE norms. 4 weeks practice teaching programme in the school they would have been exposed to the practice of micro teaching skills, pedagogical analysis with simulation and mini teaching works as the pre practice teaching days.

School Experience / Internship: The trainees would have been allotted to different practice teaching schools for delivering their 24 lesson plans where same weight age has been given on the participation of the trainees in the organization of different co-curricular activities in the concerned schools like other regular teachers. Besides, they have to conduct the construction of achievement test on two school subjects, preparation on reflective journal and conduction of action research projects relating to the problems faced by the trainees in the schools come under the purview of school experience which is popularly known as school internship now.

The process of internship in schools or school internship in which practice teaching is a major thrust occurs in the following ways as the procedural steps of the entire practice

teaching protocol -

a) The principal of the institute meets the heads of the schools for taking their consent for the said purpose,

b) Discussion with the teachers in-charge of school allotment with the student teachers for their preference in opting the schools out of the selected schools,

c) Preparation of the allotment list of student- teachers for different schools with the selection of group leader and allotment of one teacher educator as the supervisor,

d) Sending the letter with the allotment list of the student teachers to the school heads through the group leader for prior discussion regarding the allotment of

classes with proper adjustment in the time table,

e) Interactive session with the student teachers by the principal and faculty members before sparing the student teachers for their school internship,

f) Visit of the schools by the faculty members as the supervisors allotted for different schools to meet the student teachers, supervising their class room performance with the use of teaching aids and appliances and the prepared lesson plan. After that the supervisor reports his / her observations in the supervisors' observations book regularly.

3.Institutional stength

The Institution is maintaining its linkages with the school sector in relation to the Institute-school-community networking in the following ways.

- a. Conduction of school internship programs in the nearby schools
- b. Discussion with the parent guardians as the community members with the school heads if necessary where their wards do their school internship program.
- c. Instruction to the student teachers for participation in the various co-curricular and cultural programmes in the schools where they are assigned for their internship purpose and maintain the records in their Reflective Journal
- d. Rapport with the Guardians of the student teachers between the school authority and the institution authority through information about the performance of their wards in the internship programme and the assistance given by the school.

- Maybe used in any discipline or profession.


Advantages of Field Activity

Railways played an integral roll in shaping the nation write from pre independence. Railway museum set up at many important places in India aim to collect, preserve and display objects of Heritage value and presenting items for appreciation of visitors.

Railway museum at Hubballi is first of its kind in North Karnataka and second in South Western railway after the historic Mysore Rail museum at Mysore. It is centrally located next to the second entry of Hubballi railway station on gadag group opposite to Central railway hospital.

This museum is commission on 31st July 2020 and will be open to visit from 5th August. The citizens of Hubballi Dharwad and also visitors from all over the country and abroad can have a treat of railway Heritage item of yester years of railway museum at Hubballi.

At Hubballi museum artifacts are broadly arranged in three sections-within 2 cottages named Malaprabha and Ghataprabha originally constructed in 1907 and the outdoor session.

The major highlights of the museum


It includes the galaxy of rolling stock Malaprabha and Ghataprabha cottages themselves, theater coach, suruchi cafeteria, toy train, memorabilia shop, ticket printing machine display, model train run, and a children's activity room.

The museum will operate from 12 noon to 7:00 p.m. from Tuesdays to Fridays, while the same will function from 12 noon to 8:00 p.m. on weekends and public holidays the museum will remain closed every Monday.

Flight ticket charges for each adult (aged above 12) is fixed at Rs. 20, ticket prices for each child (aged 5 to 12) will be Rs. 10, visitors aged below 5 years age will not be charged for entry.




NG Wagon No. 3197 BKC: This Wagon was built in motibagh workshop in



Winch Machine (5 ton): It is a mechanical device used to live heavy objects.




They work by either wind up or wind out a roof/ cable or adjusting the tension of the rope. They are used to recover vehicles raising sails, lifting elevators and snowboarding.


Hydraulic Dead Weight Tester: This dead weight tester apparatus uses known traceable weights to apply pressure to a fluid for checking the






